

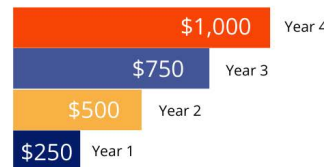


The Konza United Way Pillar Society is a network of local leaders united in addressing our community's greatest challenges and helping change lives.

Pledge Payment Schedule:

Payment on the fall campaign pledge is due by the end of the following year. A 2025 Campaign pledge should be paid in full by December 31, 2025. You may choose to pay at the time of your pledge or pay periodically throughout the year, through payroll deduction, recurring credit card or billed invoices.

**United Way** leverages local community members to review funding requests and make funding recommendations which are approved by the Board of Directors, which is made up of local citizens.

**United Way** leverages community assessments and the United For ALICE initiative to drive solutions focused on improving the quality of life for ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) families and the broader community.

**United Way** funds specific programs executed by local non-profit agencies that provide solutions to the specific needs identified in our community.

**United Way** distributes funds donated for local needs in Clay, Marshall, Pottawatomie, Riley, Washington and Wabaunsee counties.
